

THE FAMILY RECORD OF LYDIA GOLDTHWAIT KNIGHT 1812-1884



This historic record was made sometime between 1877, the year the record book was printed, and 1884, the year Lydia Goldthwait Knight died. However, it should be noted that the L.D.S. Library Catalog describes the microfilm, from which this record was copied, as deriving from a compiled work authored by Lydia Knight Young, b. 1844. It is referred to as FHL US/CAN Film [673305 item 15]. I have been unable to find any evidence cited in this record book to verify the author. The original document was filmed by the Genealogical Society of Utah in 1955. Until I find evidence to the contrary I am assuming that Lydia Goldthwait Bailey Knight McClellan was the author. Whether mother or daughter took pen in hand, one thing is impressive—the quality of penmanship.





The monument pictured in the above two photos is located at Lydia Goldthwait Knight's grave in the St. George Cemetery. Still, the name Goldthwait was not spelled in the correction the way Lydia would have it!



Orderville in the 1870's.






